

Research Participants Needed

Researchers from the University of South Florida in collaboration with the Naval Health Research Center are looking to recruit active-duty Service Members, Veterans, and civilians with a lower-limb amputation to participate in an activity study. A virtual reality system with a treadmill and moving platform will simulate realistic environments so walking and other activity patterns can be explored.



PARTICIPANT REQUIREMENTS:

- Use a lower limb prosthesis below the knee (BK), above the knee (AK) or an IDEO orthosis unilaterally due to a lower limb trauma and classified as K3 or K4 level ambulator
- Have an ability to walk without additional aids
- No allergies to skin adhesives (such as Band-Aids)
- Wear tight fitting, non-reflective clothes, and shoes during testing
- Between the ages of 18-45 years and attend a single 2–3-hour session at the CAREN Lab: IDR 114
